TWO-DAY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON CONTEMPORARY ISSUES IN COMMERCE AND MANAGEMENT - ICCICM 2022

The world today is constantly demanding new things and new ways to do things. Without research, demands would go completely unrecognized. Curiosity is the mother of all inventions. To facilitate the interchange of information, establishment of standards, new techniques and find new solutions to problems, the School of Commerce and Management of Agurchand Manmull Jain College conducted ICCICM 2022 a two-day International Conference on 4th & 5th of August 2022, on Contemporary Issues in Commerce and Management in Bhagwan Mahaveer Gyan Bhavan.



The International conference commenced with the inaugural session, a welcome note by Dr. M.M. Ramya, Dean. The conference overview was presented by Dr. E. Mahendiran, Convener. REVIVING THE ETERNAL INDIAN GLORY: FRENCH AND SANSKRIT AS GLOBAL AMBASSADORS'

The Departments of French and Sanskrit jointly organized a twoday International Seminar, 'Reviving the Eternal Indian Glory: French and Sanskrit as Global Ambassadors' on 2nd & 3rd August 2022 at Parasmal Chordia Seminar Hall. This event was organized to commemorate the 75th year of Indian independence – Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav.

The delegates of the seminar brought out the essential elements of the theme of the seminar through their presentations: Day 1:

The visiting foreign dignitaries were accorded Guard of Honour and a red-carpet welcome into the college premises. Dr. Marion Vercraene-Eairmal, Directrice, EFIS was the guest of honour. The Principal Dr. N. Venkataramanan welcomed the gathering and introduced the theme of the international seminar. The delegates were honoured with shawls and mementos. A traditional classical dance rendition by II B. Com (G) student Ms. RangaSri concluded the inaugural session. The international seminar commenced with the presentations by the delegates.Dr. Hugo David, Head of Indology of French Institute, Puducherry spoke on 'French Research Institutions in India: Their Contribution to Indian Studies'. He brought out the consistent efforts in discovering, studying and conserving the Sanskrit texts of ancient India.

Dr.R.Sathyanarayanan, charge de recherché, EFEO (French School of Asian studies), a research institution of the government of France in Puducherry brought our further crucial information in his presentation on ' Contribution of French Institutions to Sanskrit by Publishing Critical Editions of Unpublished Texts'. Manuscriptology and conservation techniques were discussed in a vivid manner. Dr.Sushant Mishra, Professor from JNU, New Delhi spoke on 'Engagement of French Scholars with Indian Intellectual Traditions' and brought out the vital facts across the centuries. Day 2:

Gaurd of Honour and a red carpet welcome was extended to Dr.K.E.Devanathan, Vice-Chancellor of Karnataka Sanskrit University, Bengaluru who spoke on 'Science hidden in Sanskrit'. He touched upon several streams of science wherein ancient Sanskrit texts had clearly brought out valuable scientific facts before several centuries.Dr. S.A.Vengada Soupraya Nayagar, Head, Department of French, KMGIPGSR, Puducherry, spoke on 'A Study on the Image of India in French Literature' and threw light on an array of elite literary figures whose work had the dominance and impact of the Indian flavour. The valedictory session was presided by the Guest of Honour Shri. Gnaneshwar Pettukola, Entrepreneur. He highlighted the validity and relevance of the Indian traditions and heritage in his speech.
