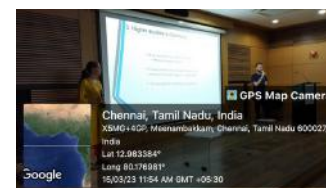


INTERACTIVE GUEST LECTURE – MARCH 2023

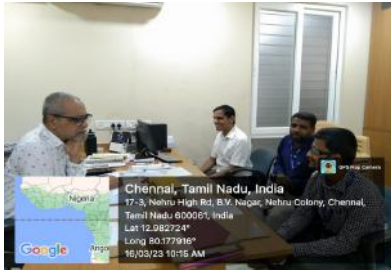
The Department of English organised a Special Lecture on the topic, "What is Inclusive Learning? : Reflections on Disability and Difference" on 16th March 2023 from 11.00 A.M to 1.00 P.M The programme began with prayer followed by Thamizhthai vazhtu. The programme was graced by Principal Dr. N. Venkataramanan, Dean Dr. M.M Ramya and Vice-Principal Dr. B. Mahavir. The welcome address was given by Dr. Sreevidhya S, Facilitator, and the introduction of the chief guest was done by Mr. Krishna Kumar S, Assistant Professor. The Chief Guest was honoured with a Shawl by Principal Dr. N Venkataramanan and Dean Dr. M.M Ramya honoured the Chief Guest with a Memento. During his speech, the Chief guest spoke about Inclusive learning and said that inclusive learning and teaching are integral aspects of the education system. Though the government had given a mandate on inclusive education in all institutions, a truly inclusive learning environment is yet to be realised. In order to educate students about the importance of inclusive learning and offering peer support for disabled students, a special lecture was organised on 16th March, 2023. Students motivated by Dr. Karah’s lecture, asked him various questions on how to build their confidence when faced with academic challenges. Dr. Karah’s lucid style of answering the questions, left students with a clear and confident mind to help themselves and those with disabilities
