The Siddha covid care centre was inaugurated by our honourable Chief Minister of Tamilnadu, Thiru M.K.STALIN at Agurchand Manmull Jain School – BALVATIKA. Respected Secretary, Associate Secretary, Principal, Chief Manager and Advisors were present during this occasion (May 11,2021).

COVID - 19 PANDEMIC

The covid 19 pandemic also called as corona virus pandemic is an on-going global pandemic of corona virus disease 2019 caused by severe actuated respiratory syndrome corona virus2. The World Health Organization declared a PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY OF INTERNATIONAL CONCERN regarding covid-19 on Jan 30,2020. Later it was declared a pandemic on March 11, 2020. The death rate during this pandemic is huge and all the nations suffer its consequences and effects.

SECOND WAVE OF COVID - 19

The second wave of covid -19 is very severe and there is huge raise in the death rate. The virus has mutated many times and still there are various unidentified mutations. People under 30 years of age constitute 32% of positive cases.



The treatment given for Covid positive patients are remarkable because it does not cause any side effect. More than 108 people have been treated successfully and discharged from the Siddha centre so far. At the Siddha Covid Care Centre, patients are given Siddha medicines, herbal drinks and good hygienic food. This treatment continues for 5 days after which they are tested negative for Covid. On their discharge, they are given medicines that are rich in nutrients and function as immunity boosters.



The Allopathy covid care centre also functions at our college. Noting the severity and worsening situation this help was extended by our management. As second wave demanded made attention in the very beginning, two covid care centres were launched and its functioning very effectively. Sufficient beds, oxygen support and other needs were timely met during the wave. Patients find comfort and solace in our great premises. They were advised to do some basic warm up exercises and yoga to keep their mind and body fresh.

When the patients recover from their illness, they are advised to be in home quarantine after discharge from the Covid Care Centre. They are taught Yoga and exercises that are required much at this time, to help recover better. Breathing exercises are also taught that help them a lot to fight against Covid 19 virus. All these special attention, formulated and executed by the Management of Agurchand Manmull Jain, have yielded good results in the health of the people who come for treatment.



AWARENESS

Various preventive measure of covid-19 was initiated at our college. Vaccination camp was one such vital awareness program been launched at AMJC to benefit the staff, parents and the public. Two doses of covaccine and covid shield had been successfully given to all with the help of Chennai Corporation and Doctors.

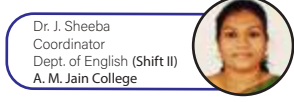
1. Staff Members & Students to give works
