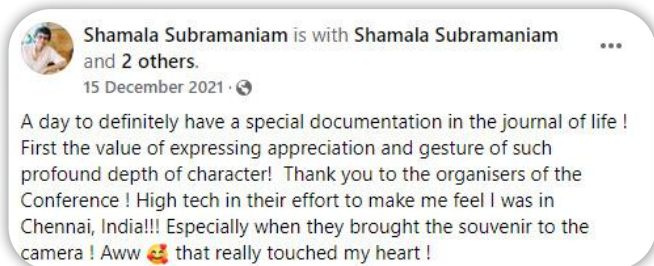
ICIARSA 2K21
