

THE ROLE OF ARTIFICAL INTELLIGENCE IN HEALTH CARE

Artificial Intelligence (AI) actually aims to mimic human's behavior cognitively. AI can be applied in various fields such as Healthcare, Cosmetics, Agriculture, Education, Finance, E-commerce, Automobiles, Robotics, Surveillance and so on. We are having different types of data in Data Science as Structured, Unstructured and SemiStructured. Structured data \rightarrow format, length and volume are clearly known. It is being used by Machine Learning methods (a subfield of Artificial Intelligence) Unstructured data is being used by Support Vector Machine, Neural Networks, Natural Language Processing and modern Deep Learning techniques (a subfield of Machine Learning). Semistructured data \rightarrow combination of structured and unstructured data. The Major areas covered by AI tools are Oncology (cancer cells),

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Neurology (neurons), Cardiology (heart MRI images) and Pulmonology (lung CT scan). Generally, AI applications are in the three major areas of early detection and diagnosis, treatment, as well as outcome prediction and prognosis evaluation. We conclude with discussion about forerunner AI systems, such as IBM Watson, and hurdles for real-life deployment of AI. AI helps the physicians for clinical decision making by flexible algorithms to observe or learn the features from a large volume of healthcare data (unstructured), and then use the obtained deep understandings to assist clinical practice and to improve its accuracy based on feedback. An AI system can assist physicians by providing up-to-date medical information from journals, textbooks and clinical practices to inform proper patient care. It helps to reduce diagnostic and therapeutic errors during the human clinical practice.





Moreover, an AI system extracts useful information from a large patient population to assist making real-time inferences (readings) for health risk alert and health outcome prediction. This training can be done anywhere with the power of AI embedded on a Smartphone, Smartwatch, Smart wearable devices and quick catch-up sessions (Chat box), after a tricky case in a clinic or while travelling. But this is just the beginning. The more we digitize and combine our medical data, the more we can use AI to help us find valuable patterns – patterns we can use to make accurate, cost-effective decisions in complex diagnostic processes.






