


NUTRITION AND ANEMIA-MYTHS AND FACTS

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INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO THE PONDICHERRY CO-OPERATIVE PONLAIT DAIRY FACTORY











The Department of Accounting & Finance, Agurchand Manmull Jain College, Meenambakkam, Chennai, organized an industrial visit to "The Pondicherry Cooperative Dairy", Ponlait dairy Factory, Kurumampet, Pondicherry - 605009, on 10.01.2024, Wednesday for PG students under the guidance of Dr. P. Rajendra Prasad, Facilitator, Department of Accounting & Finance.

The aim of the industrial visit is to provide insights on production process, quality management and administrative knowledge for the students. 14 students belonging to 1st year of M.Com (Accounting and Finance) participated the visit accompanied by 1 faculty member Ms. B. Bindu.

The journey to the industry started at 7.15 A.M. from the college campus and reached the destination by 10.30 A.M. Staff incharge of Ponlait dairy factory guided the students and explained the process of unloading, quality check, production, marketing and loading in brief.

Each and every process were viewed by the students. The average milk procurement by Ponlait from the Milk Producers' Co-op Societies every day is 50,000 litres and the same is collected through 25 Bulk Milk Cooling Centers installed across Puducherry Region after subjecting the milk for instant chilling to maintain quality.

About 40,000 - 45,000 litres per day are out sourced from the neighboring states to meet the market demand.

Ponlait effects payment to the Milk Producers on fortnightly basis based on the quality of the milk supplied by them (For FAT 4.2%, SNF 8.3% milk the rate is Rs.37/- per litre w.e.f 29.12.2022 (afternoon).

The milk is transported through refrigerated tanker vehicle from the villages to the Dairy Plant and unloaded for processing after checking the quality.

The milk is pasteurized, homogenized and standardized at the Dairy Plant before it is packed, stored and delivered to the consumers as per the Food Standards.

The industry complimented the students with ice creams. And students returned to the college around 8.00 P.M. Overall, the visit was very useful and students were highly satisfied and enjoyed the visit.




















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பொங்கல் சிறப்புப் பட்டிமன்றம்
