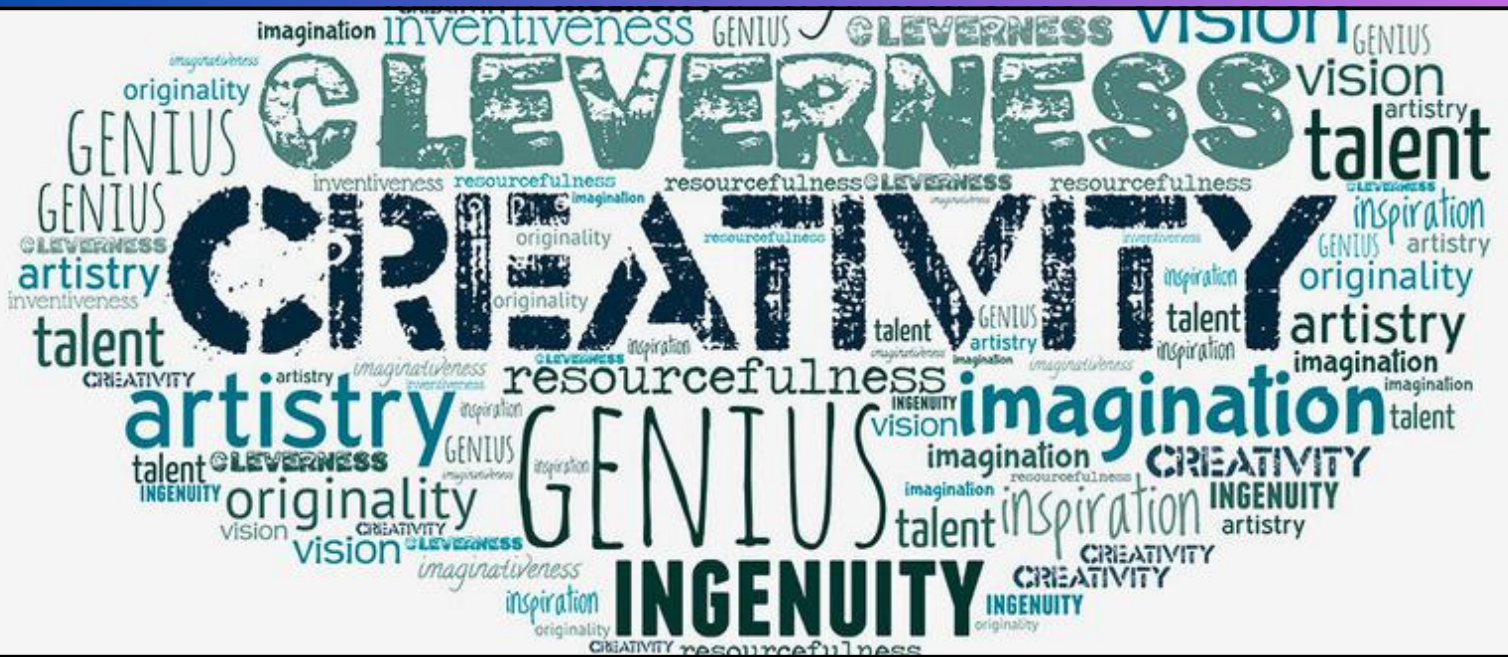

INSTITUTIONAL VISIT TO TAMIL NADU POLICE MUSEUM

The First Years students of Criminology and Police Administration visited the Historical Tamil Nadu Police Museum on 8th of November 2023. This police museum building has a great legacy. It was constructed during the colonial British rule and functioned as an old commissioner's office of Chennai police, from the year 1856 to 2013. This police museum was open to the public in the year 2021 and holds almost 200-year-old artifacts. All the artifacts displayed were collected from various police stations and not purchased. This police museum contains the entire history of the Tamil Nadu Police mainly, the medals and cups which were achieved by the Tamil Nadu Police personnel for the achievements during their service. This visit enabled the students to enhance their knowledge and understanding about the Tamil Nadu Police. Totally 52 students accompanied by 3 faculty participated in this Institutional Visit.



UNITING CORPORATES BY BLOOD RRC of Agurchand Manmull Jain College, Meenambakkam & Terapanth Yuvak Parishad Chennai jointly organized Blood Donation campaign on 29th of September 2023 in Library Block, First Floor. The camp started at 10 AM and continued till 5:30 PM with two Doctors Dr.Vijay & Dr.Sundar.

Two Nurses and seven Technicians assisted in executing the Task. RRC members registered the students for the blood donation after checking their weight, Haemoglobin, BP and primary Health. 170 Students registered and out of which 138 were boys and 32 were girls. The camp became a successful one with the donation of blood by 137 boys and a girl.



INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO ECO KITCHEN

The department of B.Com. Corporate Secretaryship organized an Industrial visit to ECO KITCHEN, INJAMBAKKAM, CHENNAI on 17th November 2023 as a part of the curriculum. Eco Kitchen has a 30,000-meal production capacity in an 18,000 sq.ft. green facility with eco-conscious technology including biomass briquettes, high energy steam vats, a biogas plant, and a steam generator.

Around 50 students were selected from the final year students for the visit and were accompanied by the Facilitator Dr. W. Julice Sudhir and two faculty members Dr.T. Devi Kamatchi, and Professor.R. Ayannar for the visit. The visit was scheduled between 10 am and 12.30 pm.

She also made the students participate in a language game—effectively, "Do as you told" involving cups—in order to demonstrate the difficulty as well as the significance of listening. It was more of an interactive lecture, whereby the Chief Guest made the students actively participate through pointed questions. The students were greatly benefited by the insights on confident communication shared by Dr. Lakshmi Krishnakumar.

The Chief Guest, Dr. Bala Agarwal, Associate Professor, Department of English, Quaid-E-Millath Government College For Women (Autonomous), Chennai



Dr. Bala Agarwal delivered the key address of the Guest Lecture. She highlighted the importance of being well-versed with the language as it is a basic requirement that recruiters seek. She focused on the concept of language, the different forms of language, importance of language skills, barriers in learning language and strategies to overcome those barriers. She emphasized on the importance of practicing the language one wants to learn, in order to develop thinking in that language. Her presentation covered the areas like SWOT analysis, interpersonal skill, useful tips and tools related to the communication skill. Her presentation on simple methods gave necessary ideas and guidelines on how to improve the basic communication skills in effective ways. By this lecture, students learnt the techniques in communication skills for their career elevation and employability in the present scenario.

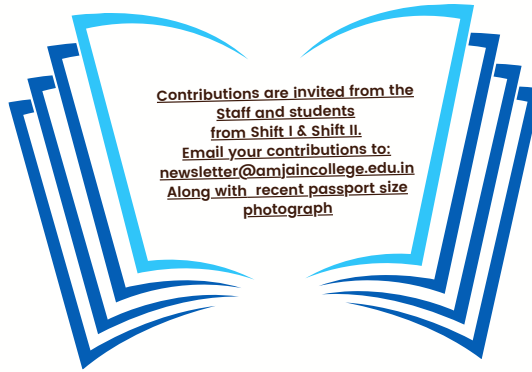
