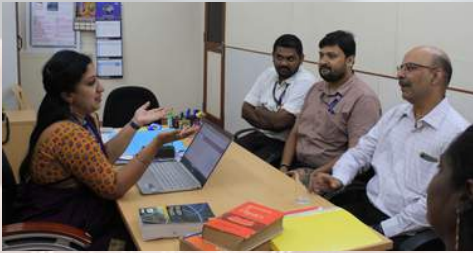


PHYSICAL SECURITY RISK ASSESSMENT AND PREPARATION OF SECURITY PLAN

A significant portion of the session was dedicated to prompt engineering, wherein students were introduced to various formats of effective prompting.

The speaker demonstrated how well-crafted prompts can inspire critical thinking, creativity, and analytical reasoning skills. By mastering the skill of prompt engineering, students were equipped with a valuable tool for enhancing their learning experience and expanding their intellectual horizons. Evaluation and Engagement to assess students' comprehension and curiosity, the speaker conducted logical reasoning and IQ tests, fostering a sense of intellectual challenge and excitement among attendees. 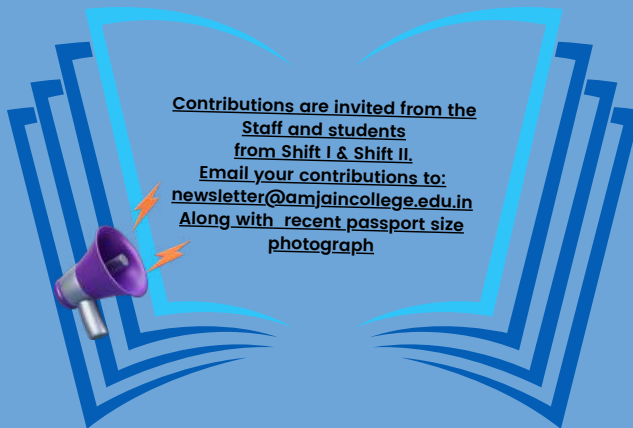
